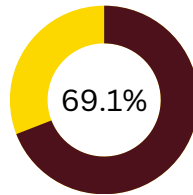

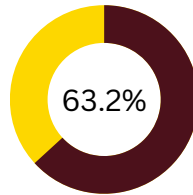
ACHIEVEMENT

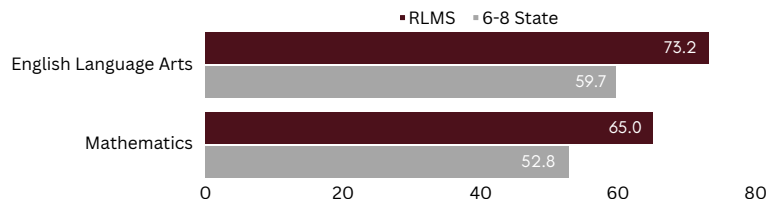

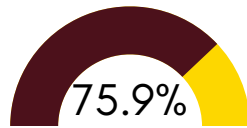
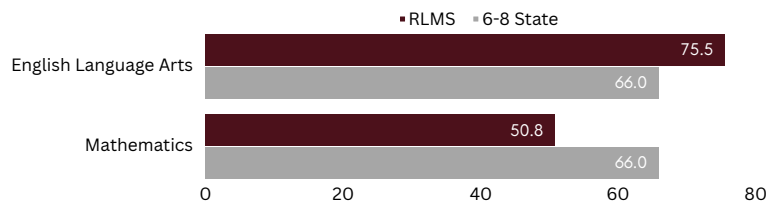

SUBJECT AREA SCORES



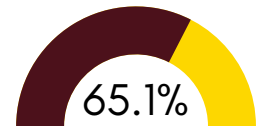

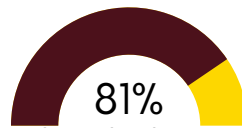

BEHAVIOR

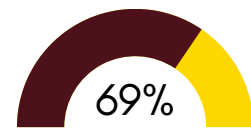

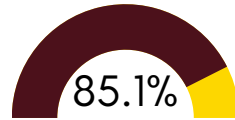

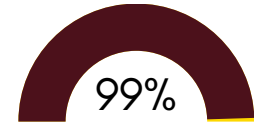

Rib Lake Middle School has robust band, choir, and art programs. Band and choir receive consistent exemplary performance recognition.

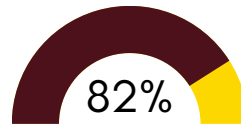
ATTENDANCE RATE
