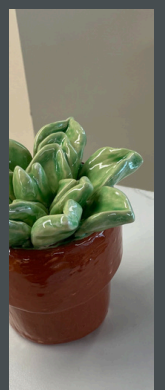
## REGIONAL FINAL CHAMPS!
