PUBLIC GIFTS TO SCHOOLS

The District may accept and use any bequest, gift of money or property for a purpose deemed by the School Board to be consistent with District goals. All gifts must be accepted by the Board, District Administrator or the District Administrator's designee. The District Administrator or his/her designee shall set criteria and procedures for accepting such gifts or bequests. Accounting for receipts and disbursements of gifts and bequests shall follow generally accepted accounting procedures.

The District will not discriminate in accepting and administrating gifts, bequests, and other aids, benefits or services to students on the basis of because of a person's sex, race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability reason or any other prohibited by state or federal laws or regulations. Discrimination complaints will be processed in accordance with established procedures.
